SAN SERVOLO, VENICE ITALY



The 1st Nunataryuk general assembly and the APECS YR workshop takes place 30 Sept - 6 Oct 2018, in Venice, Italy. They are **co-hosted by our CNR partners** at the Institute for the Dynamics of Environmental Processes and held at the premises of the Venice International University on the island of San Servolo in the Venetian Lagoon, between Venice city centre and the island of Lido. The island was originally the home of the Venetian Calbana family who, beginning in 810, hosted the seat of a Benedictine Monastery. The buildings of the island have been developed and changed over the ages along with the people who inhabited it. Today the island hosts offices of several academic institutions as well as museums.

The San Servolo was a monastic seat for a thousand years, or since 810.

The island of San Servolo is located in Venice's historic centre, across from Saint Mark's Square and only accessible by boat.

Accommodation is organised on the island at the San Servolo residential and study centre. The room price is 100 € for a single room and 150 € for a twin room. The price of the room does not include breakfast nor the Venice City Tax. Breakfast in the canteen is 9 Euro per person, while the Venice City Tax is now 3.20 Euro per person, per night. Accommodation, including breakfast and the city tax, is self-pay and is organised by the participants themselves.
